1. General Admissions Information

- ◆ Five Towns College does not have an open admission policy for all or most entering first-time students.
- ◆ The secondary school GPA is required for admissions.
- ◆ The secondary school rank in class is recommended for admissions.
- ◆ The secondary school record is required for admissions.
- ◆ The completion of a college-preparatory program is required for admissions.
- ◆ Recommendations are required for admissions.
- ◆ Auditions are required for admission to the Music and Theatre Arts Programs
- ◆ Tours of the campus and personal interviews are strongly recommended.
- ◆ The TOEFL is required for students whose native language is not English.
- ◆ SAT or ACT scores, with the Writing sections or components, are required for admissions.
- ◆ The number of entering students reporting ACT scores traditionally is very small, e.g., in the single digits.
- ◆ International students and some transfer students may not have taken SAT or ACT tests; therefore the number of test scores reported is less than the number of students entering the College.
