Elements: Author – Title of Work Cited – Title of Publication – Editor – City of Publication – Publisher – Copyright Date – Medium or Format

Article in Periodicals Research Database

Elements: Author – Title of Essay or Article – Original Publication – Volume & Number – Year of Publication – Pages – Database Name – Medium – Date of Access – URL

Elements: Author or Editor – Title of Page – Title of Entire Web Site – Edition or Version – Publisher or Sponsoring Institution – Last Update Provided – Medium – Date of Access – URL

Elements: Title – Director – Year of Original Release / Copyright – Distribution Company – Year of Version You Are Citing – Medium or Format

Music

Elements: Composer – Title of Musical Piece – Title of Sound Recording – Name of Orchestra Playing the Piece – Conductor – Publisher – Copyright Year (of that particular recording) – Format
