### ARTICULATION AGREEMENTS FOR FRESHMEN STUDENTS

Five Towns College offers freshmen students the ability to start college with transfer credits and scholarship opportunities through a variety of articulation agreements. Please see all available articulation agreements for freshmen students below.

#### ***BOCES Articulation Agreements:***

The following agreements are with the Board of Cooperative Education Services (BOCES), in Nassau and Suffolk counties. Students will be given 3-9 college credits for 1-2 year(s) of coursework in an agreed upon area. Students that complete one of the following BOCES programs will be eligible to receive a 15-50% Tuition Scholarship for up to four years of study at Five Towns College once a copy of the final BOCES Certificate is submitted to the Admissions Office.
