#### **Director's Notes**

What happens when you are teetering on the edge? That is the question a young Benj Pasek and Justin Paul explored as they wrote the Song Cycle Edges in 2005. Our incredible cast and band, led by our fearless musical director Kelly Horsted, have selected excerpts from the full song cycle and taken on the task of exploring the many characters in this exciting show. The songs cover universal issues of love, commitment, self-doubt, and self-discovery as well as the complicated relationships between siblings, friends, and lovers. We have the opportunity of having one male identifying and three female identifying actors in this cast where there are usually two females and two males. We are still surprised at how much this change of casting has brought our show to life and we hope you will be, too.

Our actors have been challenged to delve into a new character in every song. They have been asked to reach into the depths of their voices and selves to bring out honest introspection. The entire production team and I have enjoyed watching the discoveries of these actors, listening to them explore with Kelly, and sharing their ideas to create a welcoming place of storytelling. We hope you can identify with these characters and their stories, as Pasek and Paul so clearly tell us: "let it be like breathing."

#### **BENJ PASEK & JUSTIN PAUL**

Oscar, Grammy, Tony, and Golden Globe Award-winning songwriters Benj Pasek & Justin Paul are best known for their work on Dear Evan Hansen, La La Land, and The Greatest Showman. Their songs "City of

Stars" and "Audition (The Fools Who Dream)" from La La Land (with collaborator Justin Hurwitz) were both nominated for the Academy Award for Best Original Song, and "City of Stars" garnered both the Academy Award and Golden Globe for Best Original Song in a Motion Picture. Pasek & Paul won the 2018 Golden Globe for Best Original Song for "This Is Me" from The Greatest Showman, which was also nominated for the 2018 Academy Award for Best Original Song and most recently for the 2019 Grammy Award for Best Song Written for Visual Media. Upcoming projects include the live-action movie musicals Aladdin and Snow White at Disney, and an original animated musical at Fox Animation/Blue Sky Studios.




