When Bert V. Royal reimagined the beloved characters of a "certain" iconic comic strip, he stripped away the innocence of childhood to reveal the messy, complicated, and often painful realities of adolescence. In *Dog Sees God: Confessions of a Teenage Blockhead*, Royal doesn't just explore "what happens next"—he asks us to confront the very core of identity, morality, and self-discovery.

The world of *Dog Sees God* is simultaneously familiar and distorted. It captures the essence of teenage angst—heightened emotions, fleeting friendships, and the search for authenticity in a society riddled with judgment and conformity. At its heart, the play challenges us to examine the labels we assign to ourselves and others. Behind every label lies a human with fears, desires, and vulnerabilities.

Our production embraces the rawness of these characters while honoring the humor and levity that Royal weaves through his narrative like a famous blue blanket. We have worked to create a space where laughter and heartbreak coexist, reminding us that life is rarely one or the other—it's both, all at once.

Thank you for joining us on this journey. Whether you laugh, cry, or simply reflect, I hope this production leaves you with a deeper appreciation for the complexities of growing up—and the courage to see humanity in others.
