The Interactive Media Arts curriculum is designed to build a skill set in career-focused design concepts, principles and software, and emphasizes:

- Design Thinking: Using the 5-Phase Design Process of Discovery, Interpretation, Ideation, Experimentation, and Evolution
- Industry-Standard Software: Adobe software, 3DS Max, Maya, Fusion, Coding Languages, Epic Game's Unreal Engine + more
- Branding Strategies: for personal and industry use
- Portfolio Development and Career Preparation
