CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

Mass Communication students study the principles, laws, and history of the industry while honing their oral, writing, and critical thinking skills. Key learning areas include mass media, voice and diction, and emerging media.

Students then choose a concentration:

- Audio Recording Technology: Prepares students for careers in audio production
- **Broadcasting:** Trains for on-air or behind-thescenes roles in mass media
- Journalism: Focuses on writing for TV, radio, and news outlets
- Live Entertainment and Media Production: Provides expertise in production—lighting, audio, media, staging, and live event management
